**Board of Directors Meeting**

The meeting was called to order by Fr. Schubert at 4:00PM.

A motion was made by Fr. Schubert and seconded by Rose Flores to accept the minutes of the November 17, 2009 meeting. Motion carried.

**Old Business:** Sandy has received no negative feedback to the \$1 increase in the membership fees. Center members realize that the fees have not been increased since the senior center opened 27 years ago.

**New Business:** \$100 was donated to the Heritage Days Parade Committee in support of this year's parade on July 27. A banner will once again be in the parade with the center's name on it. The "Dance Around" group on Monday nights is going well. There have no problems noted. The next Saturday party will be held on May 1. We are calling this event "Derby Daze"; The Kentucky Derby will take place on May 1. Molthen Bell has sponsored the senior center by providing 9-- 2 year magazine subscriptions. Binders will also be provided to hold the magazines. Ebsco Industries donated a magazine rack. Nomination sheets will be posted on March 22; Five Senior Council representatives are needed. Elections will take place during the week of April 19. Ballots will be counted at the Sr. Board of Director's meeting on April 27. The 2 year term for the Sr. Board will expire in 2011; therefore, there will be no elections this year for the Sr. Board of Directors. Sandy thanked the following Sr. Council members for their 2 years of service: Alice Berezinski, Al Berezinski, Helen Fisher, Dolores Tolkacz and Daniela Piwaron. Beginning April 27, the senior center will be a pick up location for the "Stock Box" program from 10:30AM-11:15AM. The program is designed for seniors 60 years of age and older who meet the following income guidelines: 1 per household \$1,174/mo; 2 per household \$1,579/mo; 3 per household \$1,984/mo. Add \$406 for each additional family member. The program will be offered on the 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of each month and pick up will be in the back parking lot.
