

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

CONTRACT: PROJECT NO. 01001- 15TH AVENUE CONNECTING STREETS
OWNER: CITY OF SOUTH MILWAUKEE

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received in the office of the City Clerk of the City of South Milwaukee at the Administration Building, 2424 15th Avenue, South Milwaukee, WI 53172 until 1:00 p.m. on Friday, April 16, 2010, at which time they will be publicly opened and read for the contract, officially known as: **PROJECT No. 01001-15TH AVENUE CONNECTING STREETS**, and will include the following approximate quantities:

- Asphalt Surface 300 TONS
- Asphalt Base 430 TONS
- Pavement Removal 3,550 S.Y.
- Concrete Sidewalk 700 S.F.
- Curb & Gutter 400 L.F.
- Miscellaneous quantities of driveway approach, manhole adjustments, and storm sewer.

It is anticipated that a contract will be awarded by the South Milwaukee Common Council on April 20, 2010 and work must be substantially complete by July 2, 2010.

Bidding documents can be examined and obtained from the Office of the City Engineer, South Milwaukee City Administration Building, 2424 15th Avenue, South Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53172. There is a non-refundable fee of fifteen (\$15) dollars per set. Anyone desiring document sets by mail shall submit a fee in the amount of five (\$5.00) dollars per set in addition to the \$15 non-refundable fee, to cover shipping and handling.

BID DOCUMENTS WILL BE AVAILABLE STARTING MARCH 29, 2010.

The minimum wage scale to be paid on this project by the contractor shall be in accordance with the minimum wage rates set forth in the Bidding Documents as issued by the State of Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development pursuant to applicable sections of the Wisconsin Statutes.

Prequalification forms for 2010 are required to be on file in the Office of the City Engineer for all contractors and subcontractors at least five days prior to bid opening. The Common Council's decision as to qualification shall be final.

Proposal must be placed in a sealed opaque envelope addressed to: **“City Clerk, City of South Milwaukee, Wisconsin”** and marked **“Proposal for 15th Avenue Connecting Streets.”** If the bid is sent by mail, the sealed envelope shall be enclosed in a separate mailing envelope with the notation **“Sealed Bid Enclosed”** on the face thereof. Bid results will be available on the City website at www.ci.south-milwaukee.wi.us following the bid opening.

The City of South Milwaukee reserves the right to reject any or all bids and waive any informalities in the bidding. No bids shall be withdrawn after the opening of the bids without the consent of the Common Council for a period of thirty (30) days after the scheduled time for closing bids.

All proposals must be submitted on a form provided for that purpose as issued within the Document Set, together with a certified check or a bid bond not less than five (5%) percent of the bid, payable to the City of South Milwaukee as a guarantee that, if the bid accepted, the bidder will execute and file the contract and a performance bond in the amount of one hundred (100%) percent of the total

proposal price within ten (10) working days after the award of the contract. Failure to execute such contract and performance bond shall be cause for forfeiture of the check or bid bond as liquidated damages.
